Word	Definition
dinosaur	A type of reptile that became extinct millions of years ago.
prehistoric	The period before evidence was written down.
fossil	A fossil is the hard remains of a prehistoric animal or plant that are found inside a rock.
footprint	Mark made by an animal's foot.
skeleton	A group of bones forming .
skull	A group of bones that form the head and covering the brain.
extinct	Having died out.
scales	Small, thin bony plates that protect the skin of a reptile, usually overlapping.
carnivore	An animal that eats meat.
herbivore	An animal that eats plants.
omnivore	An animal that eats meat and plants.
paleontologist	A scientist who studies fossils.
period	A length of time.
