		<u>Food and other necessary goods:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Those involved in food production, processing, distribution, sale and delivery. • Those essential to the provision of other key goods (e.g. hygienic and veterinary medicines). 	
		<u>Public safety and national security:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Police and support staff • Ministry of Defence civilians • Contractor and armed forces personnel if critical to the delivery of key defence and national security outputs and essential to the response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Fire and rescue service employees (including support staff) • National Crime Agency staff • Border security staff • Prison and probation staff • Other national security roles, including those overseas. 	
		<u>Transport:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Those who will keep the air, water, road and rail passenger and freight transport modes operating during the COVID-19 response. 	
		<u>Utilities, communication and financial services:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Staff needed for essential financial services provision (Workers in banks, building societies and financial market infrastructure) • The oil, gas, electricity and water sectors (including sewerage) • The information technology and data infrastructure sector. • Primary industry supplies to continue during the COVID-19 response. • Civil nuclear workers • Chemicals producers • Telecommunications (network operations, field engineering, call centre staff, IT and data infrastructure, 999 and 111 critical services) linked with the COVID-19 response. • Postal services and delivery • Payments providers • Waste disposal sectors.
